
The Open Championship is the oldest of the four major championships in professional golf. Held in the United Kingdom, it is administered by the R&A and is the only major outside the United States. The Open is currently the third major of the calendar year, following The Masters and the U.S. Open, and preceding the PGA Championship.

A short history of Royal Birkdale

Since first hosting The Open in 1954, the course has been (alongside Royal Lytham) the most regular venue for the Championship other than St Andrews. At Birkdale's first Open, Peter Thomson won the first of three in succession; he returned to the same course in 1965 to add his fifth and final title.

St Andrews Sightseeing

As well as being the home of golf and famous for its Golf Courses and the R&A Clubhouse there is much more to see in St Andrews. A walking circuit of the town can take in all the main visitor attractions and some of the historic buildings this charming and quaint town has to offer. From the famous university founded in the 1400s to the striking ruins of the Cathedral and Castle. Take in the beach famous for the scene filmed there in Chariots of Fire and enjoy fresh seafood in the seafood restaurant overlooking the water.
